won't really hit the fan till  
we get through processing +  
move over to Basic. I  
don't know but I may be  
able to call before you get this.  
I had to borrow this paper,  
stamp, + envelope - They havent

taken us to the P. X. yet.  
They want let us go alone  
right now but I don't know  
where it is anyway. Well  
I can't think of much more  
to say. Barry's supposed
